

After Shouguang Vegetables, Shandong Donates Another 500 Tons of Garlic!

At 4 pm on January 31, in the courtyard of Shandongnan Vegetable Garden Vegetable Food Co., Ltd., located in Aiqu, Lanling Town, Lanling County, Linyi City, Shandong Province, 8 trucks loaded with 160 tons of Lanling vegetables and set off for Wuhan. The batch of vegetables donated for free was originally set at 100 tons, but after hearing about it, local growers asked to load some of their own vegetables and donated vegetables from 100 tons to 140 tons to 160 tons. At the same time, Lanling County donated a batch of high-quality garlic for free. On January 30, the staff of the Lanling County Commerce Bureau stated that 200 tons of high-quality 'Cangshan garlic' had been delivered, and the Wuhan City Commerce Bureau had received the batch of garlic. This batch of garlic was purchased by Lanling County Party Committee and Government at a wholesale [Garlic Price](#) of 4.4 yuan per catty from Lanling County Garlic Reserve Enterprises.

Another county in Shandong, Jinxiang County, donated 300 tons of high-quality garlic for free. On the morning of January 31, 10 large trucks loaded with 300 tons of high-quality Jinxiang garlic departed from Kaisheng International Agricultural Logistics City, Jinxiang County, Jining to support Wuhan. To ensure that the convoy arrived safely and smoothly in Wuhan, the deputy team of Jinxiang County Traffic Police Brigade of Jining City was escorted throughout. At the initiative of the Garlic Association, the manager of Shandong Jinkuang Agricultural Trading Company donated 2 tons of garlic, worth more than 16,000 yuan.

Prior to this, Shandong Shouguang donated 350 tons of fresh vegetables to Wuhan for free. At noon on January 28, the first batch of 350 tons of fresh vegetables donated free of charge in Wuhan officially began to be transported from the vegetable town of Shouguang City. The donated vegetables are worth more than 2 million yuan, including more than 20 varieties including cucumbers, tomatoes, green peppers and eggplants.

Cangshan garlic is famous all over the country. Cangshan is the best-selling in Japan, South Korea, the United States and Europe, and is the famous "Garlic Land" and "Southeast Shandong Vegetable Garden". It grows 1.2 million acres of vegetables each year, of which 320,000 are garlic. Cangshan garlic has been planted for more than 1,000 years and is known as "the world's first garlic".
